

Level and credit equivalents

The Professional Certificate in Visual Design has been allocated 12 SCQF credits at Level 7. Level 7 indicates the level of complexity of the course. The number of credit points indicates the length of time it takes to complete the course. One SCQF credit point represents an average of 10 hours of learning time.
